A committee established by the Board of Education (BOE) of St. Paul's Lutheran School and Preschool will review all the applications and, in early September, will notify each family of the amount of aid they will receive. Amounts distributed will depend on the money available in the Financial Assistance Fund as well as the number of applications. Financial assistance will be credited to your account and reflected in TADS (our tuition management system).

Applicants must submit appropriate documentation with this application in the following categories:

- Tax documentation (Form 1040)
- Documentation of government assistance (FoodShare, BadgerCare, etc.)
- Any other outstanding bills or causes for financial hardship

If documentation is not provided with this application, we will consider the application invalid.
